

St. John House of Hope Outreach Ministry 2016 Accomplishments Document

St. John MB Church, House of Hope, 501C3 non-profit Outreach Ministry, was created after God gave Pastor Fredrick Lemons, II, a vision about reaching the community. Pastor is the founder and Chair of the Board for the Outreach Ministry and directs all projects and assignments.

Since its inception on April 2, 2016, the following milestones have been reached as a result of the prayers and hard work of our board, staff, volunteers and supporters.

- April 2, Open House and Street Rededication named after Pastor Emeritus
- 200 hams given away to neighbors and church family
- May,2016, Bernice Robinson certified in Food Pantry Services for City of St. Louis
- June 5, 2016, House of Hope approved as a Food Pantry by Operation Food Search
- June 11, 2016, first full service shoppers food pantry held at church
- Provided food for 1511 households in 2016; 3,917 individuals served and 1,492 were children between the ages of 1-18.
- 125 backpacks were purchased through \$500 in gift cards from Target and Walmart and distributed in August to church family and community
- 213 Thanksgiving Bags were passed out to community and church for Thanksgiving
- Partnered with Midwest Veterans Service Alliance to provide 125 Thanksgiving meals
- 100 coats distributed to community and church family this winter
- 50 coats given to Pastor Rice and shelter
- Food given to a Community Daycare Center to provide 2250 meals from July-December.
- Two families (one church family, one community family) adopted by HOH and silent benefactors for Christmas. Each family received \$1100 worth of blessings



HOH ACCOMPLISHMENTS DOCUMENT CONTINUED.....

- HOH Prison Ministry started at St. Louis City Workhouse. Adopted family for Christmas and they received \$500 worth of blessings.
- Community Garden started in May with 25 regular beds and 4 large beds
- Tons of vegetables and fruits were reaped from the garden blessing the gardeners, community members and food pantry shoppers.
- Food Pantry was held in Chambers Park three different times
- Pastor and Andrea Carson participated in three neighborhood meetings with Alderwoman Davis
- HOH co-sponsored movie night in Chambers Park with Laymen
- Held first annual Gala on October 2, 2016, at the Savoy with over 200 in attendance. We raised \$7500 and we presented our first three Beacon of Hope Awards.
- HOH donated \$1500 to Church to purchase new Church Van
- Over 50 Christmas Trees for community and church family.
- Trained 15 volunteers
- Secured \$1000 in donations from donor/pledge cards in October
- Provided food, toiletries and socks to residents in Metropolitan Senior Apts
- Purchased HOH Food Pantry Banner
- Got blue van fixed for HOH and Food Pantry
- Started process of purchasing Post Office Building for future home of HOH
